After School For All by 2010

- Ensure a high quality after school program in every elementary school in the City of St. Louis by 2008

Council on Early Childhood Success

- Increase access to affordable child care by reducing the financial eligibility requirements and increasing the amount of subsidy payments
- Streamline the child care licensing process in the City of St. Louis
- Increase parental demand for lead poisoning testing
- Increase the saturation rate of PAT in the City of St. Louis
- Increase public awareness and citizen engagement in early childhood

Family and Community Partnership

- Create Family Support Teams in SLPS
- Increase recruitment of foster care families in City of St. Louis

Lead Safe St. Louis Task Force

- Universal and annual blood lead testing for all children under 6
- Proactive remediation of lead risks in City homes and enforcement of applicable laws
- Educate homeowners, landlords, teachers and parents with children at risk
- Coordinate and align the various lead initiatives
